- Management of occurrence reporting, data collection, analysis, tracking and trending
- Coordinating the Risk Management Patient Safety Committee efforts Risk assessment, analysis, and trending according to frequency and severity, as part of a coordinated Integrated Risk Management Plan
- Consult and educate management, staff, patients and guests on risk exposures, prevention and reduction strategies
