The Clinical Quality Coordinator works in collaboration with the Director of Quality and other hospital and medical staff to promote positive clinical outcomes and quality metrics. This position utilizes clinical databases and electronic medical records to monitor and analyze clinical outcomes and promote improvement. The Clinical Quality Coordinator supports the medical staff peer review process. Develops and maintains strong collaborative working relationships with hospital and medical staff leaders. Conducts reviews of clinical outcome data to monitor for areas in need of improvement. Develops reports and presentations on clinical outcome reviews as assigned. Gather, analyze, and present performance data to identify opportunities for improvements related to key objectives. Assists with hospital quality metric improvement, abstraction and concurrent monitoring as assigned. Supports medical staff peer review process by screening for cases using defined criteria. Attends Medical Staff and Hospital meetings as assigned to present quality reports. Participates in Internal Audits as Lead ISO Auditor. Participates on Patient Safety Council, Quality Assessment and other key Committees to represent quality and performance improvement.

Bachelor's Degree in related field required, Master's degree preferred. Licensed/Registered Healthcare individual required. Minimum of five (5) years clinical experience in a healthcare setting required. Previous experience with data analysis, clinical quality improvement and patient safety practices required. Previous experience working directly with all levels of staff, medical staff members and senior organizational leadership required. Trained in performance improvement required. Licensed Registered Nurse and Certified Professional in Healthcare Quality (CPHQ) preferred.
